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## Cliffs, cycles and cocktails in Redcar

Dramatic sea cliffs and eight miles of unbroken sands stretch from South Gare to [Saltburn-by-Sea](#) on Redcar and Cleveland's coastline. Stroll along Saltburn's magnificent 600 ft long Victorian pier, the only surviving example on the north east coast, visit Majuba Sunset Market 1 May for street food, cocktails and live music or walk part of the impressive coast path at Huntcliff with great views over Saltburn beach.

If you prefer two wheels, Guisborough Forest, the Cleveland Coast and North York Moors National Park are on the doorstep, with seemingly endless cycling opportunities.
